PROSPECTS FOR UKRAINE SYSTEMATIZATION OF LEGISLATION ON SOCIAL SECURITY

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This article explores priority areas of Ukraine systematization of legislation on social security, analyzes the scientific approaches to the problems of security and social codification of law provisions and acts of international and national legislation on social security.

Ordering legislation, codification of laws, legislation on social security.

A characteristic feature of the functioning of modern society and the state is the increasing role of law and the law as the main form of its external expression. In this context, the process of formation and development of the state Ukraine is inextricably linked with the creation of a balanced system of law. The current stage of development of Ukraine legislation on social security associated with it the need for harmonization, standardization and systematization. This predetermined number of reasons and factors, most of which are the following: the existence of a number of obsolete regulations, the need to bring them into conformity with the objective conditions of society, the need for unification of national legislation in line with international and European standards. Improving the regulatory framework is a complex process, a special place where it takes systematization, which makes it possible to take into account the nature of the social legislation of our country.

The article is research priority areas systematization of legislation of

Ukraine on social security through the analysis of scientific approaches and provisions of regulations.

In recent years, Ukraine legislation on social security has been greatly improved, however, systematization process continues as before, social legislation submitted by separate regulations. The scientific legal literature was felt that the most effective way is to systematize codification as special, the highest type of law-making, aimed at streamlining, systematic association and expression in a general law of the Act. Codification of social legislation should be directed primarily to the fact that, on the one hand, summarize the rules under which the regulation is made effective, and at the same time to set new standards that meet modern society, resolve conflicts and gaps legislation.

Attempts to develop a Social Code in Ukraine made several times, but none of these projects have not received the support of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. At its core project called Social Code of Ukraine to correct the deficiencies of social legislation, as well as organize and harmonize considerable number of legislative acts in the field of social security.

The process of codification of the law of Ukraine on social security to unite, harmonize and develop rules and principles of public relations defined in national legislation; consider Ukraine ratified international treaties; legalize positive experience in social relations, human values defined in the UN Charter, the Declaration of Human Rights, the European Convention on Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms, the recommendations of the Council of Europe and the International Labour Organization and other generally accepted international regulations, which now serve as standards on social security.
