## SOME ASPECTS OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND LEGAL REGULATION OF INFORMATION SUPPORT OF AGRICULTURE IN UKRAINE *I.Yu. LOMAKINA,* candidate of Jurisprudence Sciences, Bila Tserkva National Agrarian University

The article studies the characteristics of administrative and legal regulation of information of agriculture in Ukraine. It is concluded that such provision should be made using a set of measures of state stimulation.

Essential condition for successful agricultural production is to inform agricultural enterprises of modern science and technology, innovative technologies and best practices in the industry at local, regional and global levels.

One of the features of the administrative regulation of information support of agriculture is the implementation of information policy in this area with the use of state support measures. Therefore, an important factor in the efficiency of agricultural production is possibility to meet the information needs of agricultural producers timely.

The adoption of several regulations on the right to information contributes to efficiency of administrative and legal regulation of information support of agriculture in Ukraine. The right to information for agricultural producers is guaranteed by Article 34 of the Constitution of Ukraine and by laws of Ukraine "On Information" on October 2, 1992 and "On Access to Public Information" on June 9, 2013. Functions with regard to information support are entrusted to Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine. Administrative regulation of information support for agricultural producers involve the implementation of the State and the competent authorities of measures aimed at creating favorable conditions for agricultural producers to receive timely, complete and accurate information on social, economic and legal issues for the effective implementation of agricultural production.

The article made the following conclusions regarding to the administrative and legal regulation of information support of agriculture in Ukraine:

1) legal rules on information support of agricultural producers are contained in the regulatory legal acts of different levels, there is not a sole normative legal act;

2) current legislation assigns to agricultural producers the right to information, but does not contain an effective mechanism for its implementation;

3) due to the importance of information support for agricultural producers and its unsatisfactory at present, it is expedient to adopt of the National Programme of information support of APK development. This program is a comprehensive approach to secure information support of agricultural producers.
