UDC 349.42 AGROSPHERE AS THE BASIS FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION

The article notes that one of the novels of legal regulation is such a category as agrosphere. The author analyzes the scientific approaches to the definitionsphere on which basis it was formulated the author's definition of the term as agrolegal category, defined its meaning and value of sustainable development of agricultural production.

According to the author, agrosphere is a complex agro-legal category, which underlies the subject of agrarian law and includes the following elements: a) objects of agrarian legal relations (crops, livestock, processed soil for crops); b) certain range of subjects - rural population represented individuals who can work in farms under an employment contract to be members of or participants in such companies or engage in the conduct of the subsidiary farm; c) the scope of the implementation of agrarian rights and duties, and hence the emergence, change and termination of agrarian relations - rural development, agricultural production, etc..

In this article is was also substantiated the close relationship between the agricultural domain and the concept of sustainable agriculture, which also includes production, social and environmental dimension. Development of agroshpere in terms of sustainability implies and requires the sustainable development of agricultural production, which must be provided with adequate legal means. Addressing sustainable development of agricultural production requires an integrated, systematic approach, using set of organizational, legal, economic, legal, administrative and social media, which must found the consolidation in the Concept of sustainable development of agricultural production in Ukraine.
